



UNMIS a look at the mission in pictures



The first UNMIS-led training on the Comprehensive Peace Agreement for Southern Sudanese – representatives from various political parties, media groups and community organizations – was held in Juba on 20 and 21 March. Conducted by UNMIS Juba Public Information Office and held in collaboration with the Government of South Sudan, this workshop represents a concrete step towards fulfilling the UNMIS mandate to assist the Parties in disseminating information on the peace plan.



Similar workshops, with the aim of sensitizing state government officials and community leaders on the role of UNMIS and the CPA have been held in Kadugli, Kassala, Wau, Rumbek and Unity State. Recently, the UN Police in Juba brought together 22 senior police officers from the GoSS and GoS for a two-day Gender Training workshop. Other Mission components also regularly conduct training workshops to inform both UNMIS staff and the public on their specific functions, and to increase awareness of human rights, child protection, gender sensitivity and HIV/AIDS.
