On the Third Anniversary the of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement, UNMIS Hails Achievements Made and Calls for Doubled Efforts to Tackle Remaining Challenges

Khartoum, Juba- 9 January 2008: The United Nations Mission in Sudan (UNMIS) congratulates the Government of National Unity and the people of the Sudan on the occasion of the third anniversary of the signing of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement (CPA).

UNMIS commends the Parties to the CPA for the important achievements made so far, and for the constructive spirit they had shown in addressing key pending issues and strengthening their partnership.

UNMIS strongly encourages the parties to work in partnership and mutual trust to meet their remaining commitments under the CPA.
