Joint Press Statement by the United Nations Mission in Sudan (UNMIS) and the African Union Mission in Sudan (AMIS) on the Sixth Meeting of the Tripartite Mechanism

Khartoum, 21 February 2007: The Sixth meeting of the Tripartite Mechanism, which is made up of representatives of AMIS, UNMIS, and the Government of Sudan (GoS), was held today at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Sudan.

The meeting was informed that some of the United Nations civilian staff provided for in the UN Light Support Package to AMIS have been recruited and are presently in Khartoum. They will be deployed shortly to support AMIS, both in Khartoum and in Al Fasher. The list of the staff concerned will be officially notified to the Government in due course.

The Tripartite Mechanism will hold its 7th meeting on 7 March 2007 at AMIS Headquarter in Khartoum.
